Minutes - Topics Discussed

At the beginning, President Amitabha Datta welcomed all EC9 Members & PIs attending physically and over ZOOM Bridge Call, for participating in the 117th Executive Committee meeting of GAABESU.

Agenda Items:

1. Confirmation of minutes of 116th EC meeting - Amitabha Datta

The Minutes of the previous EC meetings were circulated in advance to all members for review. There were no further comments. Arabinda Roy proposed to accept the Minutes and it was approved by the members.

2. All Sub-committee activities;

President Amitabha Datta requested the Secretary Prosenjit Chakraborty to discuss about the activities of various sub-committees. Secretary Prosenjit Chakraborty said that the main subcommittee activity is update of Alumni Day. So, he requested Vinod Singh, the convener of the 10th Alumni Day committee to share the updates of the Alumni Day. Vinod Singh reported that the booking confirmation of the Guest house rooms, ground and Netaji Bhavan have been received from the IIEST Authority. Since some changes were made in the Brochure, the revised brochure, registration link was circulated to all alumni and various sponsors. Total 19 registrations have been done till date. We approached various companies for sponsorship. He shared the tentative budget to all. Two Fun activities will be organized for family members and children. He proposed for a Band programme but it's budget could be decided after collection. Officially 10.30 is the start time and 5.30 is the closure time of the programme. They talked with the Photography club of the college for photography and videography of the programme. Vinod Singh placed the Programme schedule and proposed budget before the members. The memento will be an instant photo of the alumnus with frame which will be organized by the photography club. Debal Banerjee asked about the transfer of the donation from abroad. Arun Deb said that the USA Foundation committee will change within a short period and new resolutions will be taken. There is a long process to send the money from abroad to GAABESU FCRA account. Seceretary said that any abroad member can send money from their NRE account. {Post Meeting Note: After checking with all concerned, Secretary has written a mail to EC Members explaining that as on date, there is no restrictions in sending money from USA, neither at our end for receiving it. Same has also been confirmed by a detailed mail from Swapan Saha from USA} Vinod Singh requested everybody to increase the head count and collect some sponsorship. He also requested the members to decide the name of the anchors. After discussion it was decided that Indranath Sinha will be the anchor of the Inaugural session, Partha Majumder will be the anchor of "Down the memory lane" and Kasturi Basu will be the anchor of Cultural programme. Syama Prasad Datta proposed for a webinar before the Alumni Day. He has talked with Biman Ghosh and Indranil Manna regarding this programme. The scheduled date may be 23rd of December. He will let all know after finalizing. Netai Ch Dey said that he has finalized the food items with the caterer.

3. Confirmation of the name of any other Permanent Invitees;

President reported that he and Syama Prasad Datta requested Arun Deb to join EC9 as PI. Arun Deb accepted their request and formal invitation letter was sent to him accordingly. President proposed his name as PI and Sitansu Sekhar Ghosh seconded. All present members welcomed Arun Deb as PI.

4. Update about 10th Alumni Day preparations;

Convener Vinod Singh reported the updates in the Sub-committee activities.

5. Update of the website;

President requested Sushanta Sinha to update on the website matter. He said that he had already talked with Subrata Ghosh, who had initially created the website for GAABESU, regarding the payment gateway which is very important to receive membership or donation. If we hire a professional team for that it could be costly and not manageable for GAABESU. He talked with some professionals. He wanted to update the website very quickly. New EC member details has already been uploaded to the website. But it was pointed out that linking website with a 'payment Gateway' has some problems, as the PAN card of GAABESU denotes as Trust not Association. Anjana Ganguly Roy gave the details how we faced problems earlier to change the PAN card number and name. Shreayan Nandy asked if it's necessary to get the payment gateway for organization like GAABESU. So, it was decided that at this point of time, we would not be able to provide link with any new payment gateway.

6. Creation of new Asst. Secretary post (Ad Hoc);

Amitabha Datta proposed Parnab Sinha's (2012 CE) name as "Assistant Secretary" on an 'Ad Hoc' basis with immediate effect. Since this post is not mentioned in our MoA, this appointment has been proposed to be an "Ad Hoc" basis. Shreayan Nandy described about his professional career. He was a recipient of GAABESU Scholarship and wanted to serve GAABESU and his alma mater in a more substantial way. All present members appreciated it and accepted this proposal.

Parnab was not present in the EC Meeting, so, Secretary Prosenjit Chakraborty will convey the decision to him officially. The members present also suggested to assign specific activities for him, as it's already there for all

other Office Bearer posts in MoA. Generally, it was mentioned that the Assistant Secretary will assist Secretary & Jt. Secretary, on need basis and at the same time, will also pick-up the nitty-gritty of running the association on a day-to-day basis. (Post Meeting Note: This is already done. He has also been briefed about the role we are expecting him to carry out).

EC members expect him to take lead in all "Student-Connect" activities, being the youngest in the sub-committee, a representative of the present millennium, and also still being close to present students. This would generally include ensuring student-volunteer participation in Alumni Day preparation activities, student participation in all seminars (online or offline), regular interaction with student bodies (including student senate GS), helping students & GAABESU for Scholarships, AFE/Research awards, Travel Grants, etc. For any help, he can always ask EC, GAABESU Office or any member, specifically.

7. Update on new membership (if any)

President said that earlier practice of waiting for an EC meeting to approve new members and then initiation of membership process, has since been discontinued. It was also not a requirement of GAABESU MoA. For quicker response now it has already been decided by the EC that no advance approval will be needed for new membership. GAABESU has already stared generating the membership number after receiving the filled-up form and money from the new member. All members present have expressed concurrence.

Secretary reported that many members joined GAABESU during August to September 2023. Out of them, 2 have joined against their donation. Their names were read out by Sri Sitansu S Ghosh and are as given below:

8. Any other issue with the permission of the chair

Debal Banerjee proposed to the EC to initiate a practice by members to intimate any subject, one wishes to raise in the meeting, under this item by an email prior to the meeting so that others may come prepared with their views. Secretary agreed and requested to proceed. He had 3 items to discuss. One, during election campaign, a charter was prepared with 9 items, when we going to discuss? One of them is very important, student outreach. He also informed that he has already contacted GS of student senate to share

news about GAABESU alumni networking, which would be very important to the current student. President explained that all these points can be discussed in student connect subcommittee and the outcome may be placed before EC. Two, there is a discrepancy between the membership fees of India & abroad. Many senior alumni, staying abroad, are now staying in India for part of the year. Some of them may not be willing to give USD 250 for membership. Again, paying \$250 for a younger alumnus at the beginning of their career abroad, may be difficult. Debal Banerjee proposed for reducing this disparity. He will send an email discussing about this to all members. Arun Deb suggested that all abroad member, NRI members should pay 250 USD. Biswajit Sen Gupta also said that it is very hard to make someone GAABESU Member. It was agreed that this being a long discussion point, let a comprehensive proposal be raised and then the matter can be discussed in subsequent EC meeting.

Shreayan Nandy proposed for a short meeting about the yearly Budget of GAABESU and yearly activities.

Partha Majumder raised a point for the I T demand of Rs 43 Lakhs and suggested to take experienced IT professional's help, as required. Arabinda Roy said that we shall submit suitable appeal against this. All agreed. (Post Meeting Note: A meeting was arranged with the Auditor on 6th November, where President, Working President, Secretary & Treasurer were present. Auditor has explained all the pending IT issues, as well as the progress made against each and also the limitations being faced. Most of these got originated because of incapable & wrong handling of issues by our previous Auditor farm during the period of 2015-2019. The Auditor has also assured us that he would give his best effort to resolve all pending issues amicably & earliest. As per him, the demand of Rs.43Lakhs would be an easier one to resolve, because of that exorbitant figure, much higher than GAABESU's annual income.)

Yearly Staff increment, PPF contributions and Mediclaim premium will be decided by the President, Secretary, Treasurer and Working President separately. (Post Meeting Note: This has also been discussed on 6th Nov, finalized and the staff have been informed).

There was no further point for discussion and the meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the chair.
